Answer: Anointing oil, mentioned 20 times in Scripture, was used in the Old Testament for pouring on the head of the high priest and his descendants and sprinkling the tabernacle and its furnishings to mark them as holy and set apart to the Lord (Exodus 25:6; Leviticus 8:30; Numbers 4:16). Three times it is called the "holy, anointing oil," and the Jews were strictly forbidden from reproducing it for personal use (Exodus 30:32-33).

Answer: The origin of anointing was from a practice of shepherds. Lice and other insects would often get into the wool of sheep, and when they got near the sheep's head, they could burrow into the sheep's ears and kill the sheep. So, ancient shepherds poured oil on the sheep's head.

Such ceremonial anointing was used under the Law in the Old Testament. The other word for anointing is aleipho"G218; i.e., rubbing with perfumed oil (Strong's). The anointing with holy oil imparts the seal of the sacrament. The sacred chrism (s.c., sacrum chrisma) that is used for confirmation is a sacramental, a blessed substance. It is one of three types of holy oil, along with the oil of the catechumens (o.c., oleum catechumenorum) and the oil of the sick (o.i., oleum infirmorum).
