NFDA Officer Candidate Guidelines. NFDA Individual Members seeking an officer position on the Board of Directors shall adhere to the following rules and guidelines. The intent of the guidelines is to encourage fair and open campaigning by: (1) specifying permitted and prohibited election-related activities; (2) informing voters about candidates' experiences and views; and (3) limiting the cost of campaigning.

Each delegate will vote only once. Once a ballot is cast, it cannot be changed.
