The top 10 leading causes of death in the United States

These diseases have remained the leading causes of death globally in the last 15 years. Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease claimed 3.0 million lives in 2016, while lung cancer (along with trachea and bronchus cancers) caused 1.7 million deaths. Diabetes killed 1.6 million people in 2016, up from less than 1 million in 2000.

The top 10 causes of death

According to the Institute for Health Metrics and Evaluation, 52.8 million people died in 2010. The WHO recorded 56.7 million deaths in 2016 with the leading cause of death as cardiovascular disease (about 31%), causing more than 17 million deaths as shown in the chart to the side.
