Seconal (generic name secobarbital), the drug most commonly used for physician-assisted suicide, was originally developed by Eli Lilly and Company in 1934 as a sleeping aid, anesthetic, and anticonvulsant (stopping seizures). The drug cost less than \$200 in 2009 for a lethal dose of 100 capsules.
