In Mark 10: 17-31 (cf Matthew 19: 16-30, Luke 18: 18-30) a rich, young man asks Jesus what he must do to inherit eternal life and is told to sell his possessions and give to the poor. He goes away sad. I have been disappointed to hear many homilies that jump to the conclusion the man never followed through and this is the end of the story.

The Story of the Rich Young Man: Is There Hope For Us ...

The issue of money, earlier discussed in Matthew 6, raises its head again with the story of the rich young man who was drawn to Jesus. The young man asks Jesus, "What good deed must I do to have eternal life?" Jesus tells him to keep the commandments, and he responds that he has done that from his youth.

The Rich Young Man (Matthew 19:16-30) | Bible Commentary ...

With surgical precision, Jesus exposes the greed in the man's heart—greed the man did not even suspect he had. Jesus' statement that only God is good (Matthew 19:18) is proved in the young man's response to Jesus' command. In His conversation with the rich young ruler, Christ did not teach that we are saved by the works of the Law.

The account of the rich young ruler is found in Matthew 19:16-22, Mark 10:17-22, and Luke 18:18-23. In each case he is found asking Jesus how to receive eternal life. Why did Jesus tell Him to obey the commandments in response?

Why did Jesus ask the rich young ruler about obeying the ...

About the rich young ruler Cockle writes: The rich young man was a know-it-all. He had such a high opinion of himself that he refused to confess his sin. When the young man heard this he went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions. And Jesus said to his disciples, "Truly, I say to you, only with difficulty will a rich person enter the kingdom of heaven.

What Jesus does in this passage is guide the rich young ruler (and us) into seeing two obstacles, between God and man, which hinder the inheritance of eternal life. Significantly, Jesus does this within the framework of the Law, thereby allowing us to have the true understanding of the real purpose of the Law.

Mark 10:17-24 Mark 10:17-24 tells the tragic story of a wealthy young man who greatly desired to become part of Jesus' following. Because he wanted eternal life and to be in God's Kingdom, he asked Jesus what he must do to obtain them. When Christ replied that he would have to get rid of all he had, his high ideals came crashing down.

What the Bible says about Parable of the Rich Young Man

The rich young man, by contrast, has an abundance of status symbols (Mark 10:22) and he owns much. (In Luke's account, he is explicitly called a "ruler," Luke 18:18.) The rich young man may miss entering the kingdom of God as much because of his slavery to status as because of his slavery to wealth per se.

The Rich Young Man and Attitudes to Wealth and Status ...

The rich young man said, "Teacher, I had obeyed these commandments since I was a small boy." Jesus looked at the rich young man and He loved him. Jesus said, "Sell all your possessions away and take the money and give them all to the poor as charity. Then, take up your cross and come and follow Me."
