The first successes turned the emperor's head, and he decided to put the "barbarians" on his knees, declaring China from December 1839, "closed" to all merchants from England and India. All British businessmen, their goods and ships in January 1840 were removed from Guangzhou.

First Opium War (1839-1842) - About History

At the end of the war Great Britain had won her object of opening China to general English trade and to the opium trade, in particular. By the Treaty of Nanking (1842) Hong-Kong was ceded to the conquering power, and later that island became a British Crown colony and naval station.
