What are protective factors? Protective factors buffer against risk in otherwise adverse circumstances by either reducing the impact of risk, or changing the way a child or young person responds to it. The Social Development Strategy provides a framework that explains to communities how to increase protective factors through everyday interactions with children and adolescents.

Protective Factors. Risk factors are linked to a greater likelihood of sexual violence (SV) perpetration. They are contributing factors and might not be direct causes. Not everyone who is identified as at risk becomes a perpetrator of violence. A combination of individual, relational, community, and societal factors contribute to the risk of becoming a perpetrator of SV.

Both risk and protective factors may be internal to the child (such as genetic or personality traits or specific behaviors) or external (that is, arising from the child's environment or context), or they may come from the interaction between internal and external influences.

The evidence on risk and protective factors for maltreatment is far from definitive. Although a few factors (e.g., low socio-economic status) are consistently associated with child abuse and neglect, the empirical research has produced inconsistencies and conflicting findings. The evidence on risk and protective factors is limited in several ways.
