Suppose $x = g_1 h_1 \cdots g_n h_n$ lies in the center of $G * H$, where $g_i \in G$ and $h_i \in H$. For any $g \in G * 1 H$, we have $g g_1 h_1 \cdots g_n h_n g^{-1} = h_1^{-1} n g^{-1} n \cdots h_1^{-1} g^{-1} 1 = 1$. The only way for this to be true for all g is if $h_i = 1$ for all i .
